

### October 19 Luncheon - Andy Shaw - Executive Director, Better Government Association



Andy Shaw has covered local, state and national politics for 37 years, 26 of which were spent at WLS-TV. Retiring after President Obama's swearing in ceremony to "recharge my batteries," Shaw is back as Executive Director of the Better Government Association (BGA). He also contributes articles to a variety of publications and serves as a frequent guest host on WLS Radio.

Previously, Shaw covered political campaigns and elections, presidential primaries, conventions and debates for ABC 7. Prior to that, he was an education reporter and then editorial director at NBC 5, where he won several awards, including two local Emmys.

Before working in television, Shaw served as education editor at the Chicago Sun-Times where he won several awards, including first prize in the 1976 American Association of University Professors competition, for a series he wrote on the University of Illinois at Chicago. Prior to joining the Sun-Times, Shaw spent two years as a general assignment reporter for the City News Bureau of Chicago. Born in Chicago and raised in Evanston, Shaw and his wife Mary run the Windy City Urban Inn, a bed and breakfast in Lincoln Park. They have three daughters: Kate, a lawyer at the White House; Elizabeth, an administrator for the New Orleans Recovery School District; and Emily, a graduate student at the University of Illinois.

### Board Nominating Committee
