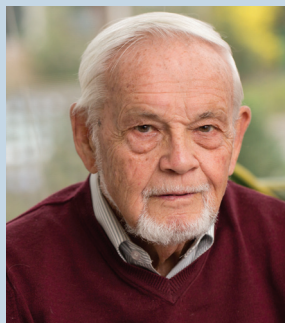

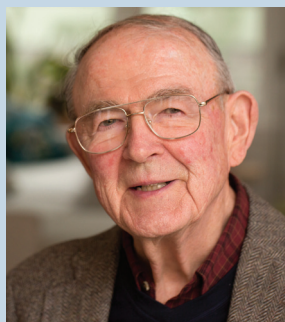

How You Can Become a Newton at Home Member

Membership is available to anyone living in a Newton household in which one individual is 60 years of age or older. Annual membership dues are \$660 for an individual living alone and \$780 for a household of two or more.

A group of Newton at Home volunteer drivers provides members with money-saving private car transportation to Logan, doctor appointments, local and Boston medical facilities, supermarkets, pharmacies, and many other metropolitan area destinations. You pay only for tolls and parking when needed, and a small fee for trips to Boston.
